

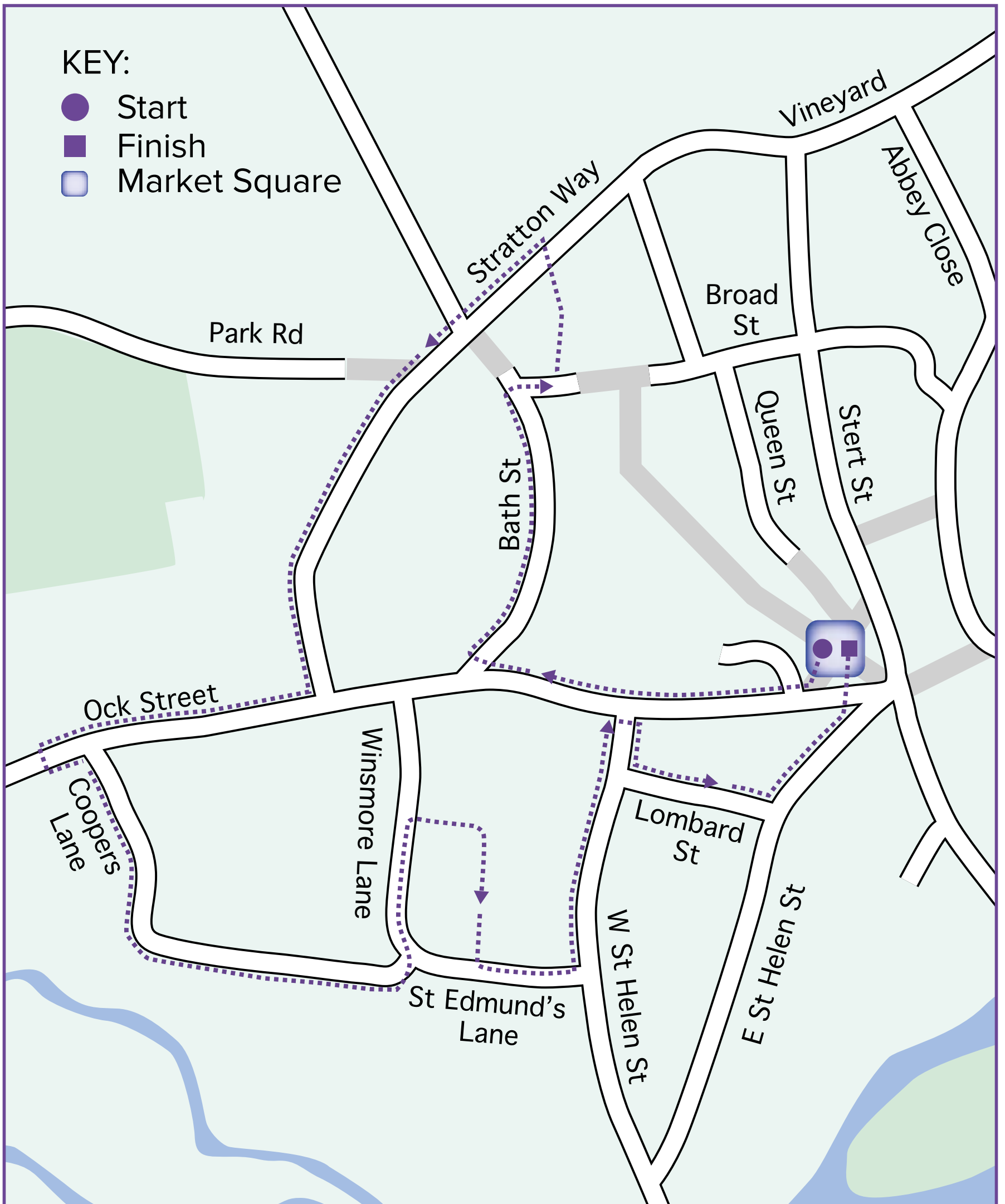

ABINGDON'S

Purple Walk

Find these quirky features around Abingdon. Just follow the route and tick the boxes of the features you find.



Quirky features

Wander through arches and alleyways and discover doors, windows, artwork and other quirky bits of the town that you didn't know were there. The Purple Walk mixes the old and the new.

Purple route:

- Start in the Market Square
- Face Abingdon Museum and turn R into the High Street
- Turn first R into The Square and walk round the War Memorial and along Bath Street
- Turn R in front of the Bella Napoli restaurant
- Keep L to go through the underpass
- Turn L up the slope to N side of Stratton Way
- Cross (Upper) Bath Street
- Continue along Stratton Way and turn R along Ock Street
- Cross at pedestrian crossing and turn L back along Ock Street towards town
- Turn R into Coopers Lane
- Follow Coopers Lane through Brewery site development
- Turn L into Winsmore Lane and take first R into Neave Mews; take a close look at the art here
- Turn around and go under the road arch out of Neave Mews; take a L along St Edmund's Lane

- Turn L up West St Helen Street to corner of High Street and at the end cross over
- Turn back down West St Helen Street and L into Lombard Street
- At end, turn L along East St Helen Street
- Go L at Punch Bowl, behind the County Hall Museum and return to Market Square











We hope you have enjoyed this walk. Return to the Market Square for some well-earned refreshment
