Go to the South East corner

Cross Stert Street (by Pedestrian Crossing)

Turn Right to pass St Nicholas Church

Turn **Left** to go under Abbey Archway

Cross Abbey Close, head **Right** then **Left** through gateway into Abbey Gardens

Follow path to **Left** into the low opening in wall

Turn to view position of site of Abingdon Abbey

Continue on path round to the gateway to the car park B9

Through car park go straight along Abbey Close

Turn **Right** down the path behind Waitrose Store

Follow path until turn **Left** into Vintner Close

Turn **Right** under the road arch and **Right** into Penlon Place

Walk down to car park and cross bearing Right

Go under arch on path through Thames View

Follow path to Road and dogleg **Left** then **Right** down the pathway **B16** 

Cross the bridge over the Mill Stream

Turn Right along the path beside Mill Stream

Cross the bridge to Abbey Close car park

Walk up Abbey Close and turn **Left** down Checker Walk **B20** 

Go straight on through the narrow passageway

Turn **Right** into Thames Street


At end of Thames Street turn **Right** up Bridge Street

Return to the Market Place.
