Follow the purple trail to see some quirky features and the site of Morland Brewery



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
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## Abingdon-on-Thames Self Guided Photo Quiz Purple Walk

Wander through arches and alleyways and discover doors, windows, artwork and other quirky bits of the town that you didn't know were there. The Purple Walk mixes the old and the new. We hope you will enjoy finding these places, just follow the route and look for the features. We have labelled a few for you.

Start in the Market Place. Here is ...

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Then face the Old County Hall. Turn **Right** along the High Street

Turn first **Right** into The Square (with War Memorial)

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Keep **Right** along Bath Street

Turn **Right** in front of the Bella Napoli Restaurant

Keep **Left** to go through the Underpass

Turn **Left** up the slope to N side of Stratton Way. Cross (Upper) Bath Street

Continue on Stratton Way to find...

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At end of Stratton Way turn **Right** along Ock Street. Look for on the other side of the road, and then...

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Cross at Pedestrian Crossing and turn **Left** back along Ock St

Turn **Right** into Coopers Lane

Follow Coopers Lane through Brewery site development. Before going through bollards at the end of Cooper's lane, look for

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Turn immediate **Left** into Winsmore Lane (not signed) and take first **Right** through a narrow passageway into Neave Mews

Turn **Left** to view...

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Also look for

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Turn round, keep the passageway on **Right** and go under the road arch out of Neave Mews, then turn **Left** along St Edmund's Lane

At end cross and turn **Left** up West St Helen Street to corner of High Street


Turn back down West St Helen St and L into Lombard St..

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At end, turn **Left** along East St Helen Street

Go **Left** at Punch Bowl behind the County Hall

Return to the Market Place.
