Visit our Roysse Room exhibition to rediscover some of our town's lost buildings (from mansions to the workhouse) and view pictures of the town taken during the Second World War **Sat & Sun 10am - 4pm** 

Call in to Unit 25 in Bury Street to see what was there before the precinct and Charter, and why it all changed in the 1960s and 70s

Fri - Mon 10am - 4pm

Enjoy a re-enactment of Roman life and witness rural building crafts of a bygone age in the ancient Abbey Buildings *Sat 10am - 4pm* 

Visit some of the 12 or more fascinating buildings which are opening on the Saturday: new for this year are the Old Gaol foyer, the ultra-modern Sophos Building and Christchurch Barn conversion.

Explore the rich architectural history of our parish church, St Helen's.

Take a guided walk on the Sunday, or follow one of our self-guided trails.

There is plenty to see and do all weekend for all the family and, using a treasure map, you could win cinema tickets whilst exploring more of our historic town.
